- All COVID-19 vaccinations are voluntary. If you have recently received any other vaccine first, the CDC recommends wait at least 14 days before getting your COVID-19 vaccine. - You should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19. If you were treated for COVID-19 with monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma, you should wait 90 days before getting a COVID-19 vaccine. Talk to your doctor if you are unsure what treatments you received or if you have more questions about getting a COVID-19 vaccine.
