May 4, 2021	Churchrock Chapter For individuals, ages 18 years & older. First dose of the Moderna vaccine for all priority groups.	9 am - 2 pm
May 5, 2021	UNM-Gallup Campus For individuals, ages 16 years & older. First doses of the Pfizer vaccine for all priority groups: Youth ages 16 & 17 years, must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.	9 am - 4 pm
May 6, 2021	UNM-Gallup Campus For individuals ages 16 years & older. Second dose of Pfizer vaccine for individuals from 04/14/21 event, ages 16 and older in all priority groups; Youth ages 16 & 17 years must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.	9 am - 4 pm
May 6, 2021	Twin Lakes Chapter For individuals, ages 18 years & older. First dose of the Moderna vaccine for all priority groups & individuals.	9 am - 2 pm

- All COVID-19 vaccinations are voluntary. If you have recently received any other vaccine first, the CDC recommends wait at least 14 days before getting your COVID-19 vaccine. - You should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19.
