NAVAJO AREA INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE COVID-19 VACCINE EVENT SCHEDULE FOR WEEK OF JUNE 14, 2021

Window Rock, Arizona --- Navajo Area Indian Health Service (NAIHS) service units continue to offer COVID-19 vaccines at local health facilities and community vaccination events.

June is the [National Month of Action, mobilizing an effort](#) to get 70% of U.S. adults at least one vaccine dose by July 4. The IHS supports this goal and the national public education campaign, [We Can Do This](#), to help Americans make informed decisions about COVID-19 vaccines to protect themselves and their communities

Let's reach community immunity! Protect yourself. Protect your family. Protect your elders. Let's do our part. Getting vaccinated yourself may also protect people around you, particularly people at increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19.

The Indian Health Service (I.H.S.) is committed to continue increasing equitable access to vaccines. The NAIHS is following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the Navajo Nation priorities, with the goal of vaccinating as many people as possible.

All COVID-19 vaccinations are voluntary. ***Note: It is crucial for patients to complete both doses of the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines for the best protection against COVID-19.***

COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective. COVID-19 vaccines were evaluated in tens of thousands of participants in clinical trials. The vaccines met the Food and Drug Administration's rigorous scientific standards for safety, effectiveness, and manufacturing quality.
