**NAVAJO AREA INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE COVID-19 VACCINE EVENT
SCHEDULE FOR WEEK OF APRIL 26, 2021**

Window Rock, Arizona --- Navajo Area Indian Health Service (NAIHS) service units have COVID-19 vaccines available at local health facilities and community vaccination events.

Let’s reach community immunity! Protect yourself. Protect your family. Protect your elders.

The Indian Health Service (I.H.S.) is committed to COVID-19 vaccine availability for all individuals within our health care system. The NAIHS is following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the Navajo Nation priorities, with the goal of vaccinating as many people as possible.

All COVID-19 vaccinations are voluntary. If you have recently received any other vaccine first, the CDC recommends wait at least 14 days before getting your COVID-19 vaccine. To review frequently asked questions about the COVID-19 vaccination, visit:

You should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19. If you were treated for COVID-19 with monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma, you should wait 90 days before getting a COVID-19 vaccine. Talk to your doctor if you are unsure what treatments you received or if you have more questions about getting a COVID-19 vaccine.

The events are subject to change based on weather and other factors.
