Who can get a vaccine?

- Individuals 65 and older and essential personnel with a current patient medical record (chart) at Gallup Indian Medical Center.
- Individuals ages 16 to 64 years meeting the following **criteria**: ESRD, Solid organ transplant on immunosuppression, Down syndrome, current cancer, pregnancy, CKD Stage 3-5, diabetes, COPD, Obesity (BMI over 30), heart failure, coronary artery disease, or cardiomyopathy, immunocompromised state from blood or bone marrow transplant, immune deficiencies, HIV, or use of immune-weakening medicines, asthma, cerebrovascular disease (previous stroke), Cystic fibrosis, cerebrovascular disease (previous stroke), Cystic fibrosis, hypertension, neurologic conditions such as dementia, liver disease, pulmonary fibrosis, sickle cell disease or Thalassemia.
- Must live within the Gallup Service Unit Area

What to expect?

- You must commit to getting a 2nd vaccine in four weeks on Saturday, March 6
- Bring a driver and/or Navajo interpreter if needed, a pen to complete forms, and valid identification to verify age and residence
- 15-30 minute observation following vaccination
- Possible long wait times. Please be mindful of your elders needs and be sure to bring snacks and drinks.
- Please have your medical record number readily available in order to verify your information.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

You should not get a COVID-19 vaccine if you:

- Have had a known COVID-19 exposure and are currently quarantined
- Have symptoms of COVID-19, including a cough, fever, shortness of breath, or loss of taste or smell
- Have a pending COVID-19 test
- Had any other vaccine in the past 14 days
