Gallup Service Unit (GSU) COVID-19 Vaccination Events Planned on Saturday, February 13, 2021

Gallup, New Mexico --- Gallup Service Unit will have a vaccination event on Saturday, February 13, 2021 to provide **second doses** of the COVID-19 vaccine for those who received their first vaccine dose on January 23, 2021 at the UNM-Gallup Campus.

The event will take place at the University of New Mexico – Gallup campus from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Please bring the CDC vaccination card provided to you with the first dose and your medical record number.

Expect long wait times. Be prepared by bringing food, water, and any other necessities while you wait.

- To provide second doses of Covid-19 vaccine for those who received their first dose on January 16, 2021 and to provide 150 first dose (Prime)
- Wednesday, February 17, 2021 8am -11am
To provide 150 first dose (Prime)

The CDC recommends to not receive the COVID-19 vaccine within two weeks of receiving other vaccines. Due to the severe health risks associated with COVID-19 and the fact that reinfection with COVID-19 is possible, you should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19 infection. If you were treated for COVID-19 symptoms with monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma, you should wait 90 days before getting a COVID-19 vaccine. Talk to your doctor if you are unsure what treatments you received or if you have more questions about getting a COVID-19 vaccine.
